GERMANWINGS FLIGHT CRASHES IN FRANCE

NON OF PASSENGERS HAVE SURVIVED

USPA NEWS - There were two babies on board the Germanwings Airbus 320 that crashed in southern France. And among the 150 victims there are 16 children from a school in Germany..

Operations with the recovery of bodies could take weeks. While hoping there is a survivor in the airbus tragedy that seems to have been spotted moving among the wreckage. The airbus, which had suddenly lost altitude, was on an abnormal route. Moments and the plane crashed in the Alps. Then hours of shock across Europe.

The Airbus A320 Germanwings, low cost airline of Lufthansa, crashed near Barcelonnette, in southern France, the Massif 'Trois Eveches'. All of the 150 people on board, 142 passengers and six crew members have died. However, the Interior Ministry in Paris said that until the wreck is not reached there can be no certainty that there are no survivors.

Hollande called Merkel: "Mourning and Tragedy" The wreck in an inaccessible area, assistance will arrive in a few hours. The wreck at a level of 2,700 meters, debris scattered within a radius of two kilometers. There was also a German school NRW consisting of 16 boys and two teachers on board. The boys were returning from an exchange student trip. Mystery remains on information about the only survivor of the tragedy: General David Galthier, head of the gendarmerie of Provence, reported that "a body would have been spotted moving" near the wreck.
